

All 2194 Words Beginning Mem and Nun, by Frequency

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The table shows, for example, that μA and $VRgthi$ are the most common words in Biblical Hebrew not represented elsewhere in Classical Hebrew, and that $fPvthi$ is most common word found in Biblical Hebrew, Ben Sira and Qumran (but not Inscriptions).
