

Would you like the opportunity to become involved in cutting-edge research at the University Of Sheffield this summer?

As part of the Sheffield University Undergraduate Research Experience (SURE) a sponsored position is available for an undergraduate to spend 6 weeks on the project:-

“Gaining functional snap-shots of environments in order to overcome changes brought by climate change”

The main aim of the project is to increase the feasibility and know-how of dealing with proteins in troublesome environmental samples. Extraction methods will be compared and contrasted as well as identification strategies through mass spectrometry.

What do you get?

This scheme offers opportunities for undergraduate students at The University of Sheffield to become directly involved in the research activity of the University, take part in ‘real life’ research projects, experience what it’s like to work in partnership with academic staff or collaboratively in a research group, gain transferable skills in areas such as project management, collaboration and communication; increase awareness of the academic research environment and career options within it; as well as an enhanced CV and employability. Students will be paid a standard rate of £180 per week full-time and pro rata part-time.
