Rail Travellers: To find the Frederick Mappin Building which is on Mappin Street, I would recommend: (i) take the tram from the railway station towards town and get off at the West Street stop (5-10 minutes). Mappin Street is then directly across the road; (ii) you can take a taxi from directly outside the station but it is less than a mile by foot.

Car travellers: Parking is notoriously expensive in Sheffield and traffic is bad at peak times. If coming from the M1, use the park and ride (accessed on the road from J33 about 1 mile before the centre) and you can avoid entering the centre. Regular trams run directly from the park and ride to the West Street stop opposite Mappin Street. If coming across the Pennines on the A57 you will arrive at the university directly and could use the map on the website to locate possible parking, but this will entail coming into the centre.

Finding the lecture theatre

The event is going to be in LT7 of Frederick Mappin Building on Mappin Street. This is, roughly, a backwards (viewed from sky) capital F shaped building. The main entrance would be at the middle of the top of the F, LT7 is at the very bottom of the F and 2 floors up. From main entrance, turn left follow corridor going around a right angle right hand turn, then up 2 flights of stairs, then walk for another 50yds or so.
