MA in Management Research

This course is an ideal preparation for MPhil or PhD research in management or as a stand-alone course to provide transferable skills for a research career. The programme forms part of the UK Economics and Research Council (ESRC) 1 + 3 model for a doctoral programme.

Profile of typical candidate

Applicants should have either a 2:1 (or its international equivalent) or an undergraduate degree plus a Masters degree. All applicants should also demonstrate a specific interest in management research: this MA is not an alternative to an MBA or an MSc in Management. All applications are considered on individual merit.

Entry Specification

Our standard English requirements for overseas students are: IELTS 7.0 (with no less than 6 in each part), or equivalent grades in the University of Sheffield English Proficiency Test. No other qualifications are accepted.

Aims

- To prepare students for the writing of an MPhil or PhD thesis in management
- To provide generic, transferable skills for a research career

The programme forms part of the UK Economics and Research Council (ESRC) 1 + 3 model for a doctoral programme and carefully observes ESRC research training requirements. It may be taken as a stand-alone qualification in its own right.

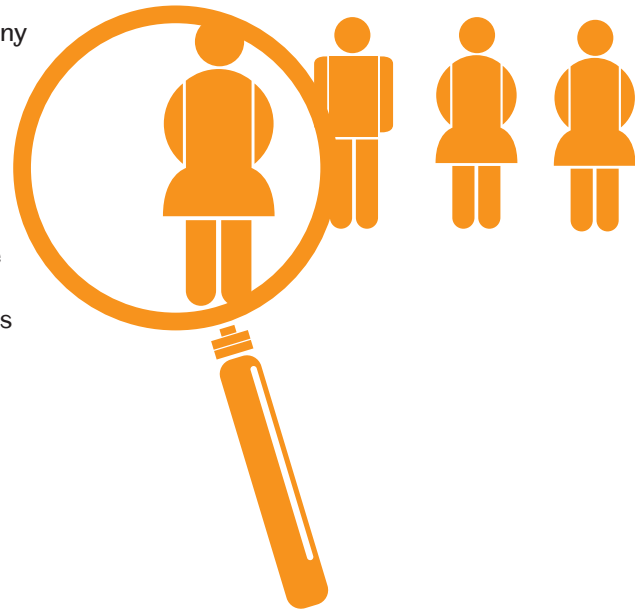
- Supervised Learning in a Management Specialism or any other master's level module.
