MSc in Leadership & Management

This programme brings together theoretical and applied expertise to focus on the development of leadership skills within the current international context of the changing nature of work. The programme is designed to enable current and future managers to become effective leaders by understanding and developing human capital in organisations.

You will examine a range of prominent leadership theories as well as current cutting-edge research topics, such as positive organisational behaviour and authentic leadership. The topics covered will be of high practical relevance to future leaders, including cross-cultural leadership, the challenges of globalisation and the management of conflict to prepare you for the demands of the contemporary workplace.

You will acquire a good understanding of how to create and support positive change, how to successfully manage and implement the process of change and how to tackle management errors. You will learn how to develop a business vision, how to motivate individuals and groups and how to stimulate innovation and initiative in organisations.

Profile of typical candidate

The MSc in Leadership and Management is designed for ambitious managers who are looking to develop their leadership skills. The programme content is designed to reflect closely the real-world business environment and focuses on the applied skills and expertise sought by modern employers. You may be a specialist in a particular field looking to develop your management skills with a view to promotion or you could be a generalist wanting to obtain more knowledge and experience with regards to leadership and the management of people.

The programme will provide students with a combination of theory and practice and a supportive learning environment, where they will have the opportunity to test out new concepts and ideas within the field of leadership.

Entry specification

A 2:1 honours degree, or approved professional qualification

Our standard English requirement for overseas students is IELTS 7.0 (with no less than 6 in each part). If you are unable to take IELTS we will consider TOEFL 600 with TWE 4.5 (paper-based) or TOEFL (computer-based equivalent).

The interactive and group-based nature of some of the modules requires a high level of spoken English.
