Access for all

The Octagon Centre has a ramp, to the right of the main entrance, for wheelchair users. A lift is available for access to each level. Disabled toilet facilities are close to the main entrance near the Porter's Lodge.

You can access the Students' Union lift by following the signs for the East Entrance. Once you are in the East Entrance go through the right hand set of doors to get to the lift which is outside the Auditorium. There are disabled toilets on every level.

For wheelchair access to Firth Hall, please report to the Porter's Lodge using the intercom at the front of the building.

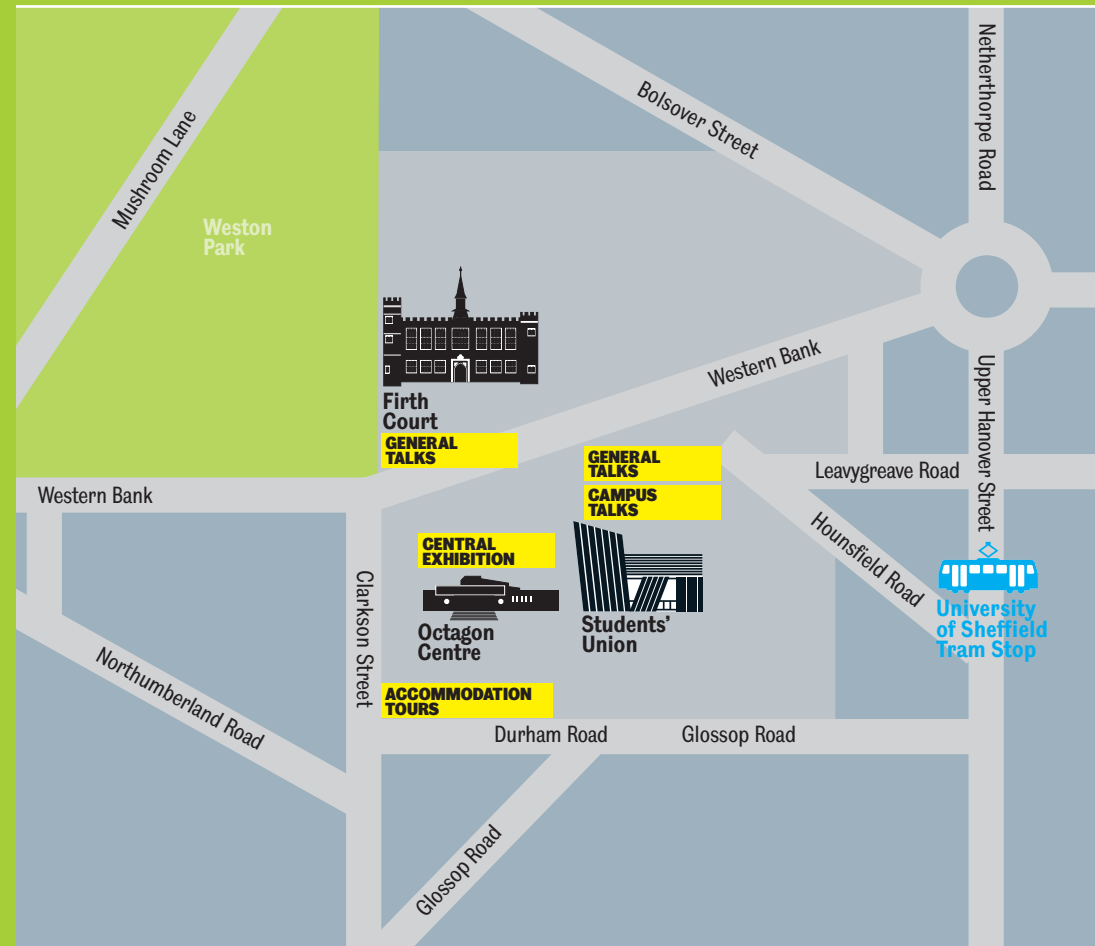
Emergency procedures

Our Open Days are flexible. General talks are repeated throughout the day. Apart from the departmental talk you've booked to attend, the structure of the day is up to you.

Central exhibition

Drop in at the Octagon Centre (map ref 118) and talk to specialist staff about the admissions process, careers and employability, opportunities to study abroad, money, accommodation, the Students' Union and more. At the general information stand, staff are happy to answer questions. You can pick up a prospectus, maps, a pen and refreshments. The exhibition and the Octagon Café are open from 10am to 4pm.

Mature students

Engineering and Physics

Maths exhibition

If you are interested in maths but not sure which course to choose, visit the Hicks Building Foyer (map ref 121) to talk about your options. You will be able to speak to staff between 11am – 11.30am, 12.30pm – 2.30pm and 3.30pm – 4pm.

Biological sciences information

If you are interested in biological sciences, but not sure which course to choose, visit the Alfred Denny Building (map ref 112 – South Entrance) between 11am and 2pm to discuss your options. Academic staff from the departments of Animal and Plant Sciences, Biomedical Science, and Molecular Biology and Biotechnology will be available to answer your questions.
