## **MA in Town and Regional Planning**

A 12 month course enabling students from a wide range of backgrounds to gain the skills and knowledge required to enter a career in planning.

## **MA in International Development and Planning**

Focussing on the challenges facing the Global South, this programme prepares graduates for careers in an international planning context. It critically engages with issues of social justice and environmental sustainability and their relevance for planning and development practice.

*Both these courses are fully accredited by the Royal Town Planning Institute, allowing graduates to become chartered members once necessary practice requirements have been met.*

## **MA in Commercial Property**

A 12 month MA for students from different backgrounds interested in commercial property surveying. It contextualises the operation of property markets by studying economics, valuation, law and investment, enabling students to fully engage with the profession.

## **MA in Planning and Development**

A 12 month MA for students from different backgrounds interested in the development and regeneration of property. It contextualises the operation of property markets by studying economics, valuation, law, development and planning, aimed at those seeking a career in planning and development surveying.

*Both these courses are accredited by the Royal Institution of Chartered Surveyors (RICS) enabling graduates to become chartered once necessary practice requirements have been met.*

## **MA in Planning Research**

This MA provides a solid grounding in the principles and practice of social science research and is for people wishing to specialise in research in planning or a related field, either as the first step towards studying for a PhD or for a professional career. The programme is recognised by the UK Economic and Social Research Council as a 'research training' masters and can be taken as the first stage of a 1+3 PhD.
